

DALBY MARKET REPORT 6th March 2024

Total Yarding -5201 GDL -1094

Numbers were up this week in Dalby. The usual panel of buyers were present and operating, but to specific buying guidelines. Overall, the market softened-10c/kg, with more significant reductions seen in the plainer types and high content lightweight yearling cattle returning to the paddock in both the steers and heifers, with prices back as much as 30 to 40c/kg in those categories.

Next week GDL are selling 2nd.
